DAY 1 * 8th Nov: D

Arrive in Cairo, your transfer to your hotel is arranged by us. Settle in and we meet for a group dinner this evening. We do recommend you arrive one day earlier as flights can be very tiring and day 2 siteseeing is a full day !! *Pre-tour accommodation can be arranged for you.

DAY 2 *9th Nov : B

Today we visit the Giza Plateau with it's magnificent Pyramids and then we drive to the Saqqara Archeological site and to the first pyramid built, Step Pyramid and Serapeum. Optional add on camel ride 1.5 - 2 hours





DAY 3 *10th Nov: BLD

Valley Of the Whales : Wadi al-Hiten heritage site is our next stop. Many Whale fossils have been found here, dating back to 25 to 33 million years old.

We drive from Cairo to Tunis and jump in a 4 wheel drive and head off to our spot to camp over night in the desert, close to Valley of the Whales. Dinner will be Bedouin style cooked over a camp fire. And we can relax, do some yoga or meditation and spend the evening star gazing.

DAY 4 *11th Nov: BD

Breakfast in the desert, before we head towards Tunis.Today you can explore Tunis and try your hand at pottery.

Dinner will be together at the Ibis Restaurant. We overnight at the Olive Tree Lodge.

DAY 5 *12th Nov : B

Today after breakfast we head back to Cairo. On route we plan to stop off at Pyramid Meidum.

Meidum is an archaeological site in Lower Egypt. It contains a large pyramid and several mudbrick mastabas. The pyramid was Egypt's first straight-sided one, but it partially collapsed in ancient times.


We will be catching an evening flight from Cairo to Aswan. We stay on Elephantine Island in a small guesthouse with magic views overlooking the Nile River, or similar.



Day 6 *13th Nov: B L D

An early start this morning as we visit Abu Simbal.Located near the Egyptian border with Sudan is one of the most impressive places in Egypt, known for its two massive temples and colossal monuments carved into the rock. They were erected on the orders of Pharaoh Ramesses II in the 12th century BC to display the power of Egypt to the visitors from Nubia.

Due to the construction of the Aswan High Dam and the creation of Lake Nasser, the temples of Abu Simbel were at risk of flooding. To protect them from destruction, in 1964–1968 the temples were moved above the water surface to a place about 65 m higher than their previous location. The Egyptian government and UNESCO funded the operation. A short boat ride to visit Philae Temple. We will also take a boat to the Nubian Village. You have free time in the evening to check out the local market.







Day 7 *14th Nov : B L D

This morning we board a luxury Dahabiya sailing boat and set off down the Nile River for 3 nights of bliss, as we float along the Nile. Relax, reset, enjoy the view of daily life along the Nile. Today we visit Komobo Temple.

Day 8 *15th Nov: BLD

You will have the privilege of visiting the Temple of Horus at Edfu. Marvel at the scenic beauty along the Nile as you approach the temple, setting the stage for an immersive and magical encounter with ancient history.



DAY 9 *16th Nov: B L D


Our last night onboard the sailing boat. We moore at Esna overnight.

DAY 10 *17th Nov : B

Disembark the boat and we are transfered from Esna to Luxor. We visit Karnak Temple & Luxor Temple on the West Bank in Luxor. Stay at Embrace Hotel (or similar) on the West Bank .







DAY 11 *18th Nov : B

Visit Habu Temple, Valley of the Kings and Possibly Valley of the Queens, all on the West Bank. We stay Embrace Hotel, or similar.

DAY 12 *19th Nov : B L


Today we travel to Dendera, it was an important site for the worship of Hathor, who was the goddess of music, dance, joy, love, and motherhood in ancient Egyptian religion. We The Great Temple of Abydos, also known as the Temple of Seti I, is a remarkable ancient Egyptian temple located in Abydos, a sacred site in Upper Egypt. This temple was commissioned by Seti I, the father of Ramses II, and was primarily dedicated to the god Osiris. Stay at Embrace or similar.

Today is a free day for you to explore Cairo. Here is a suggestion for you. I will arrange a driver for you. Day 15 *22nd Nov : D

Arrive Dahab

We catch an evening flight from Cairo to Sharm El Sheikh. Arrive in Sharm. Transfer to Dahab.

Here we are met by our driver who will take us to Dahab. Its about a 1.30 hours drive.

On our journey you will be intrigued by the beauty the desert mountains hold, as we drive to Dahab on the Sinai Peninsula. Reddish pink tinged mountains meet the brilliant vivid blue oceans of the Red Sea. These mountains cradle Dahab, which boasts mesmerising snorkeling and diving, its reefs are filled with a magical underwater land.

Dahab also has restaurants which line the waterfront, they have lots of outdoor seating to take advantage of the view across the ocean to the Saudi Arabian mountains. I love the freshly squeezed juice bar, I can show you all, where my fav ones are located.

Stay at Lidia Hotel


Day 16 *23rd Nov : B D

Today is a fun filled adventure day. We head off into the desert to camp overnight at Zig Zag Canyon. Trust me you will be in heaven. Bedouin's will whisk us through the desert, showing us points of interest along the way, which include desert inscriptions left by nomadic tribes. Tonight we dine Bedouin style beside a campfire under a star filled sky.

Day 17 *24th Nov : B

Breakfast cooked on the campfire. We visit the ancient Nawamis tombs, these are older than the pyramids and were built by the nomadic tribes that roamed the Sinai for centuries. We continue on to a Bedouin village, where we will meet the locals living in the desert today. This evening after dinner we will head to a belly dancing and fire show in the mountains.





DAY 18 *25th Nov: B

Snorkel 3 Pools & ride a camel. (Optional add on) Optional Dinner at Al Sultans Kitchen for a yummy lamb dinner. Tonight around 10pm we drive about 2 hours to St Catherines for our overnight hike. The hike is about 2 hours. Snacks are available along the way on the hike.

DAY 19 *26th Nov : B D


Hike Mt Sinai - St Catherine


