DAY 1 *5th Nov : D

Arrive in Cairo, your transfer to your hotel is arranged by us. Settle in and we meet for a group dinner this evening. We do recommend you arrive one day earlier as flights can be very tiring and day 2 sightseeing is a full day !!

*Pre-tour accommodation can be arranged for you. Fees will be charged for any extras not on the itinerary.

DAY 2 *6th Nov : B

Today we visit the Giza Plateau with its magnificent Pyramids. We visit Saqqara Archaeological Site and the visit pyramid built, Step Pyramid and then Serapeum.



DAY 3 *7th Nov : B D

Today is a free day in the crazy city of Cairo. We have an option to do a tour of the city. A min of 2 people is required for this.

You visit some really amazing sites ; visit Islamic Cairo, Coptic Cairo, The Tanner (Cave Church), The National Museum of Egyptian Civilization and lastly in the evening head to Khan el Kahili night market. This is an Optional Add on with a cost TBC closer to the time. Entry fees not included.

DAY 4 *8th Nov : B

Today you are free to visit the GEM in your own time, or simply have a free day.

DAY 5 *9th Nov : B

Today we drive from Cairo to the Valley of the Whales, where we will camp overnight under the stars. Experience a dinner under the stars cooked by the Bedouins.

DAY 6 *10th Nov : B L D

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DAY 7 *11th Nov : B

Breakfast in the desert, before we head to Cairo. We have a flight to Aswan later in the afternoon.

Arrive in Aswan and we head to Elephantine Island for dinner at a restaurant overlooking the Nile River.

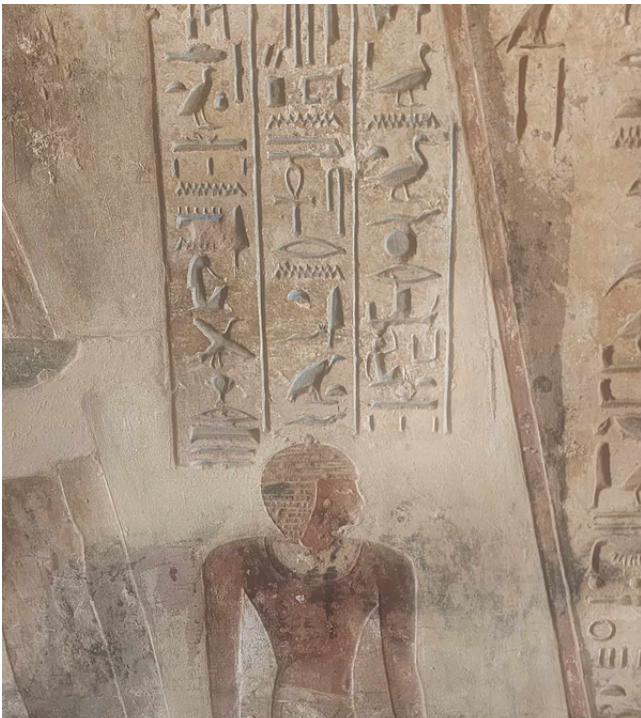

DAY 8 *12th Nov : B D

An early start this morning as we visit Abu Simbal. Located near the Egyptian border with Sudan is one of the most impressive places in Egypt, known for its two massive temples and colossal monuments carved into the rock. They were erected on the orders of Pharaoh Ramesses II in the 12th century BC to display the power of Egypt to the visitors from Nubia.

Due to the construction of the Aswan High Dam and the creation of Lake Nasser, the temples of Abu Simbel were at risk of flooding. To protect them from destruction, in 1964–1968 the temples were moved above the water surface to a place about 65 m higher than their previous location. The Egyptian government and UNESCO funded the operation. A short boat ride to visit Philae Temple. We will also take a boat to the Nubian Village. Stay at The Mango Guest House or similar.



DAY 9 *13th Nov : B L D

This morning we board a luxury Dahabiya sailing boat and set off down the Nile River for 3 nights of bliss, as we float along the Nile. Relax, reset, enjoy the view of daily life along the Nile. Today we visit Komobo Temple.

DAY 10 *14th Nov : B L D

You will have the privilege of visiting the Temple of Horus at Edfu. Marvel at the scenic beauty along the Nile as you approach the temple, setting the stage for an immersive and magical encounter with ancient history. All meals are included on board our luxury Dahabiya.

DAY 11 *15th Nov : B L D

Our last night onboard the sailing boat. We moore at Esna overnight.

DAY 12 *16th Nov : B

Disembark the boat and we are transferred from Esna to Luxor. We visit Esna Temple Stay at our chosen hotel on the West Bank of the Nile River. In the afternoon we visit Karnak Temple and Luxor Temple on the east Bank of the Nile River. Stay at Embrace Hotel or similar.

DAY 13 *17th Nov : B L

Visit Habu Temple, Valley of the Kings and Valley of the Queens, all on the West Bank.

We stay at Embrace Hotel or similar. We join friends to sail and enjoy yoga, sound healing and yoga nidra in the evening.

DAY 14 *18th Nov : B

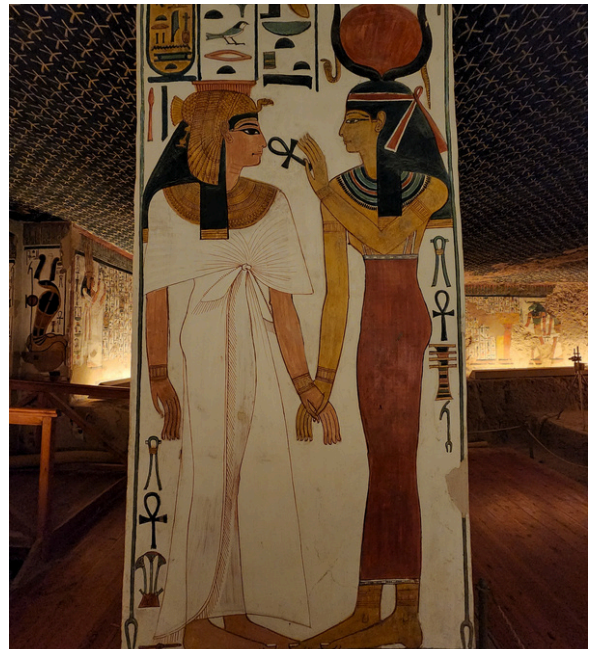
Today is a free day, we can offer some options. Perhaps the early morning Hot air Balloon over the Valley of the Kings. We can visit a school that has been started for the children. We stay at Embrace Hotel or similar.

DAY 15 *19th Nov : B

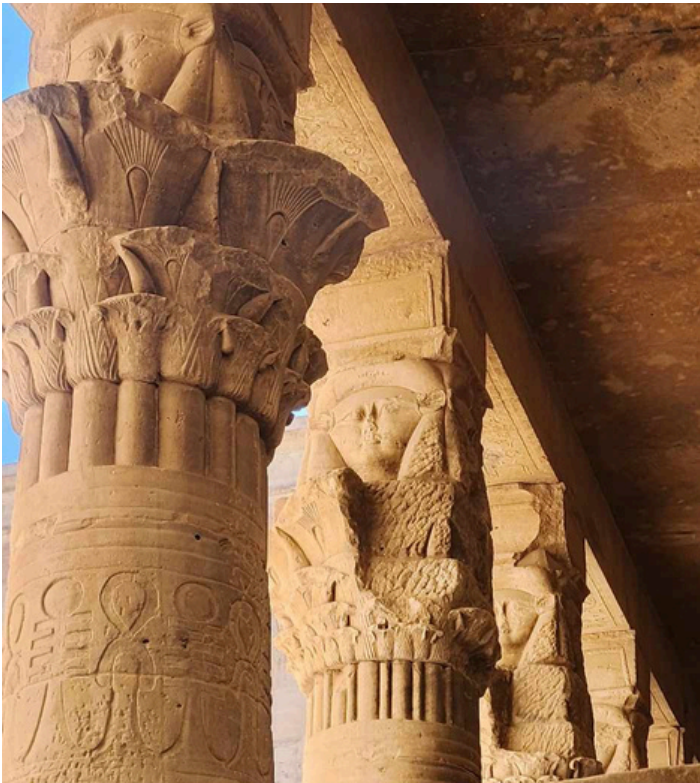
A short flight to Cairo in the morning and fly onto Sharm el Sheik later in the afternoon or similar. Then we fly to Sharm el Sheik where we will be met at the airport. we drive through the gorgeous mountains to the seaside town of Dahab. Dahab means Gold.

On our journey you will be intrigued by the beauty the desert mountains hold, as we drive to Dahab on the Sinai Peninsula. Reddish pink tinged mountains meet the brilliant vivid blue oceans of the Red Sea. These mountains cradle Dahab, which boasts mesmerizing snorkeling and diving, its reefs are filled with a magical underwater land.

Dahab also has restaurants which line the waterfront, they have lots of outdoor seating to take advantage of the view across the ocean to the Saudi Arabian mountains.











Day 16 *20th Nov : B D

Snorkel the famous Blue Hole, this is one of the top 5 dive spots in the world. We can also snorkel Blue Lagoon. Tonight we have dinner and then head to a show in the mountains, enjoy a fire show, belly dancing and more.

Day 17 *21st Nov : B D

Today is a fun filled adventure day. We head off into the desert to camp overnight. Trust me you will be in heaven. Bedouin's will whisk us through the desert, showing us points of interest along the way, which include desert inscriptions left by nomadic tribes. Tonight we dine Bedouin style beside a campfire under a star filled sky. Relax with yoga, a sound bath and to finish of Yoga Nidra.

Day 18 *22nd Nov : B D

Breakfast cooked on the campfire. We visit the ancient Nawamis tombs, these are older than the pyramids and were built by the nomadic tribes that roamed the Sinai for centuries. We continue on to a Bedouin village, where we will meet the locals living in the desert today. We head back to Dahab, and you are free to shop, snorkel and explore.



DAY 19 *23rd Nov : B

A free day to do some more exploring or swimming and snorkeling. If you want to dive and have your Padi Certification, a dive can be arranged for you, at an extra cost.

Optional Dinner at Al Sultans Kitchen for a yummy lamb dinner. Tonight around 10pm we drive about 2 hours to St Catherine's for our overnight hike. The hike is about 2 hours. Snacks are available along the way on the hike and blankets can be hire at the top of Mt Sinai.

DAY 20 *24th Nov : D

After watching the sunrise, we hike down Mt Sinai and spend some time at St Catherine's Monastery. Arrive back in Dahab around lunch time. Tonight we enjoy a beach night with a lamb meal and other yummy food, we will share laughter and music.



DAY 21 *25th Nov : B

Today we head to 3 pools for snorkeling and a 4 x 4 safari into the desert canyon. This evening we head to a Bedouin music and dance show in the mountains.

DAY 22 *26th Nov : B

Today you will be transferred to Sharm el Sheik airport. From there you will catch a flight onwards home or carry on with your journey.
